SUMMARY: Proof of Insurance Law (Supplement)

STATE: Georgia

APPLICABILITY: Commercial Automobile

EFFECTIVE DATE: February 8, 2002

Please be advised that the Georgia State Legislature has recently passed House Bill 994 which is effective February 8, 2002. This law extends the validity of insurance identification cards as official proof of insurance for policies issued to a named insured who is a “*natural person*” (an individual rather than a corporation or other legal entity) until January 31, 2003.

If you have a “*natural person*” named as an additional named insured on a “*commercial vehicle policy*” in the state of Georgia, and that “*natural person*” has a vehicle registered in his/her name that is listed on the vehicle schedule of the aforementioned “*commercial vehicle policy*”, that vehicle is subject to the reporting requirements of the “*Georgia Electronic Insurance Compliance System*”. This even though the vehicle is part of a “*commercial vehicle policy*”.
