New York Motor Vehicle Liability Insurance Motor Vehicle Law Enforcement Fee

The New York State Insurance Department has issued Circular Letter No. 10, dated May 30, 2003, which outlines the changes to the *Motor Vehicle Law Enforcement Fee* as the result of recent legislative activity.

The amendment, effective June 1, 2003, requires every insurance company authorized to transact motor vehicle liability insurance to collect a fee of five dollars (\$5.00) for each insured vehicle. A copy of the full circular follows for your reference.

This fee will be implemented into the CoverAll system; for those offices not using the CoverAll processing system, the appropriate system changes should be made to comply with this updated regulation.
