NOTICE OF NONCOVERAGE OF FLOOD DAMAGES AND THE AVAILABILITY OF FLOOD INSURANCE

Effective July 6, 2005, Senate Bill 256 adds 33-17-6a, Notice of Noncoverage of Flood Damages and the Availability of Flood Insurance, to the Code of West Virginia, to specify that every property and casualty insurer issuing or renewing a policy that provides FIRE insurance, but does NOT cover damages from flood, shall provide a notice along with every policy that state the following:

"This policy does not cover damage from flood. For information about flood insurance, contact the National Flood Insurance Program or your insurance agent."
