**New York Attorney General/DOI Policyholder Notice**

As a result of a recent settlement agreement with the New York State Attorney General and New York State Department of Insurance, the property & casualty insurance companies of American International Group, Inc. are required to establish a website and send a notice to policyholders with regard to compensation paid to insurance producers (as more specifically defined in the settlement agreement). The website discloses the nature and range of compensation paid to insurance producers and the notice refers policyholders to the website or a toll free number. This correspondence is to notify you that the enclosed Policyholder Notice must accompany any and all new or renewal business issued on or after July 18, 2006. Please also note that the website and toll free number will not be activated until July 18, 2006.
