Maine Commercial Auto

Effective June 27, 2007, the Maine Legislature repealed the electronic filings requirement for auto insurance cancellations, non-renewals, or other lapses in coverage, pursuant to Title 29-A s 1601-A.

Therefore, insurance carriers are no longer required to report to the Maine Secretary of State, the cancellation, termination or lapse of motor vehicle policies, covering vehicles registered in the State of Maine. This law also applies in those situations where we lose a Commercial Auto Policy at renewal due to competition.
