eSTART Announcement

AIG must identify and monitor any potential insurance policies issued to a US Government Entity in order to avoid being classified as a government contractor. Status as a government contractor requires compliance with various laws promulgated by the Federal government with respect to employment standards. In order to control our exposure an edit has been programmed into the eStart system.

A "block" in eSTART will take effect this Monday, October 1, 2007 to flag US government entities. When a "hit" occurs, the following message will be generated.

" 'Federal Government Entity Block: This account is an entity of the United States Federal Government.
