
- 1. The Line Fire has burned 21,203 acres and is 3% contained as-of Monday, Sept. 9th
- 2. More than 36,000 homes and other structures are threatened according to CalFire.
- 3. Evacuation orders were in place for Running Springs and Arrowbear Lake, and evacuation warnings were issued Sunday for Lake Arrowhead, Cedar Glen, Crestline and Valley of Enchantment.
- 4. Fire officials said Sunday that their efforts had been challenged by erratic wind conditions, smoky air and limited resources.
- 5. Hot and dry weather will continue Monday with an Excessive Heat Warning for the lower elevations of the fire.
