1. Francine currently has max. sustained winds of 60 mph, is moving NNW at 5 mph, and is located approximately 180 mi (285 km) SSE of the mouth of the Rio Grande, TX.




- 2. Francine is forecast to be a hurricane when it reaches the northwestern Gulf coast on Wednesday.
- 3. A hurricane watch is in effect for the Louisiana coast from Cameron eastward to Grand Isle.
- 4. A storm surge watch is in effect for High Island Texas to the Mississippi/Alabama border, covering all of the Louisiana coast.
- 5. A risk of flash and urban flooding exists across portions of the mid-South from Wednesday into Friday morning.
