2. Event Details:


- 1. The Mountain Fire started on Nov. 6th and has currently burned 20,630 acres, with 7% containment
- 2. Evacuation orders are in effect at least 14,000 people have been told to evacuate and the fire has threatened at least 3,500 homes, businesses and other structures
- 3. As of Thursday, 132 structures are reportedly destroyed, mostly homes. 88 additional structures have been damaged.
- 4. Status as of Friday the Santa Ana wind event that fueled the fire's rapid initial spread is ending and fire activity is moderating. But the fire is burning in steep, rugged terrain, with dry and receptive fuels, which have challenged containment efforts. The fire remains a threat to critical infrastructure.

3. Moratorium Duration:
