

NEVADA

COUNTERSIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS apply to all insurers and to all types of insurance.

Exceptions are: health; risk retention group policies; bid bonds; life and annuities; reinsurance and retrocessions; and rolling stock or other property of or in transit with any common carrier, maintenance of its plant and business as a common carrier of freight or passengers and policies to risk purchasing groups.

THE COUNTERSIGNATURE AGENT must be a licensed resident agent who is appointed to the issuing insurance company.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Countersignature endorsement can be used only if attached to the policies to which it applies, and the policy insures persons or property in Nevada and in another state.

The countersignature agent must keep a record of all policies countersigned.

Commissions, fees and premiums of the policies requiring countersignature must be paid to the countersigning agent. The insurer must provide for such payment of fees and commissions. The countersignature agent must receive at least 5% of the premium. The countersignature agent may waive commissions if the annual premium is \$250.00 or less. Licensed nonresident agents may receive remainder. The countersigning agent may be paid for additional services.

No commission may be paid to unlicensed resident or nonresident agents.
