

## OKLAHOMA

**Countersignature Requirements** apply to all insurers except where noted below, and to all insurance and surety bonds on property or operations in Oklahoma regardless of residence of insured or place where contract is made.

**Exceptions** are: reinsurance; life; health; reciprocal; ocean marine insurance; bid bonds; insurance on rolling stock, vessels or aircraft of common carriers in interstate or foreign commerce; property in course of interstate or foreign trade; vehicles principally garaged and used in another state including liability insurance involving such property; accident and health and policies issued to risk purchasing groups.

**THE countersignature agent** must be a resident or nonresident agent licensed in Oklahoma who is appointed by the issuing insurance company. It must be a resident if the nonresident agent's home state requires a resident countersignature.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

Please provide the countersignature agent with proof of license and appointment when sending a policy for countersignature. This proof can be in the form of a print out from PLSearch. Please also include a copy of the Declarations Page of the policy, a self-addressed, stamped envelope and Form 2261. If all of these items are not included your countersignature request will be returned to you.

The countersignature may be a facsimile of the agent's signature if prior authorization has been received from the agent. The countersignature agent must keep a record of all policies countersigned for at least three (3) years. There are no restrictions on distribution of commissions among licensed agents, except retaliatory with a nonresident agent's home state.

**Commissions may not be paid to unlicensed resident or nonresident agents.**
